

Principal's Message



Dear Parents,

We begin the season of Lent this week with the celebration of liturgy on Ash Wednesday. The symbol of the ash cross on our foreheads serves as a reminder that we come from God and return to Him. The forty days of Lent offers an opportunity to renew our faith and spirit, and to become better

versions of ourselves. Peter J. Murphy, Director of the Secretariat of Evangelization and Catechesis at the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops offers some thoughts on traditional Lenten practices: *Prayer: Fasting: Almsgiving.*

"<u>Prayer</u> is essential to a Christian's daily life, but it can get lost in the busyness of daily living. Allow Lent to be a prayerful journey. Spend time as a family reading the bible and reflecting in both discussion and prayerful silence. <u>Fasting</u>: Catholics fast during Lent to experience sacrifice and also to appreciate the blessings and gifts that sometimes are taken for granted. Fasting reminds us of our needs, especially our need for God.

Catholic abstain from eating meat on Fridays during Lent. *Almsgiving:* Sharing our resources help us learn generosity. Breaking selfish tendencies, we learn to recognize and serve the needs of others. Sharing with others reveals that our blessings are gifts to be shared."

We approach the Lenten season with an *ATTITUDE of GRATITUDE* for our God-given blessings. Through Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving, we hope to become the best version of who God created us to be. During Lent, it is empowering for our children to focus on positive actions and practices (spending quality time with a younger sibling; offering part of weekly allowance to the missions; doing extra chores at home) rather than negatives such as "giving up" something. You may decide as a family to begin a new positive tradition in your home that recognizes blessings, and motivates sharing and service. Your Monday Messenger next week will contain a sixweek Lenten calendar, which offers practical suggestions on positive practices during Lent.
